❖ N.S.S Advisory Committee Meeting :-

A meeting of Advisory Committee was held under the headship of the vice chancellor of the university on Dt.22/07/2016 at 12:00 AM. The tasks which are to be carried out during the year were discussed.

The state Government has provided the strength of 12,500 NSS volunteers to the University. Looking at the efficiency of the affiliated colleges of the University and the demands from the new colleges for the fresh Units, strength for the units were allotted.

As per the order No.NSS/T.No.1/121-35/2016 of the Dept of Higher Education, Gandhinagar, the strength of the volunteers were 12500 for regular activities and 6250 for special camp. It was resolved to allot five university level camps to the affiliated colleges having NSS unit. Besides that a budget was granted for the expenses of the year.
