2. The Strength of the Volunteers

As per the order No. NSS/T.No.1/121-35/2016 of the Department of Higher Education, Gandhinagar, and the strength of the volunteers were 12500 for regular activities and 6250 for special camps. 19th October, 2017, Thursday: The volunteers from different regions of Gujarat gathered at Ahmedabad Junction. The train took off at 10 a.m. on the Diwali morning.

20th October, 2017, Friday: The train reached the station at 10:30 a.m. where the volunteers of Shreyas College of Engineering received the volunteers of Gujarat and escorted them to the campus. 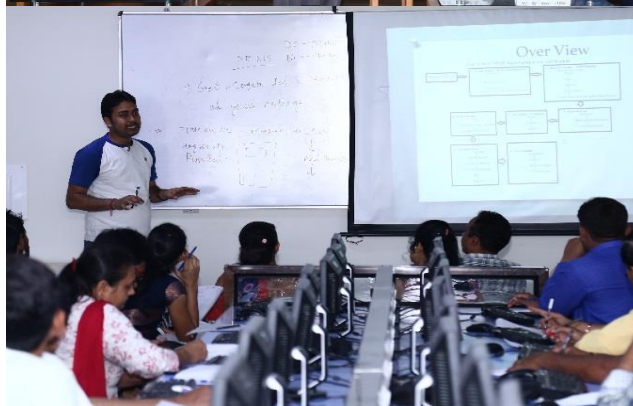

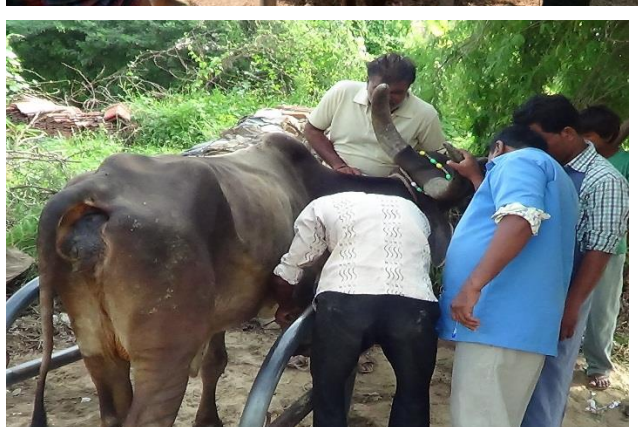

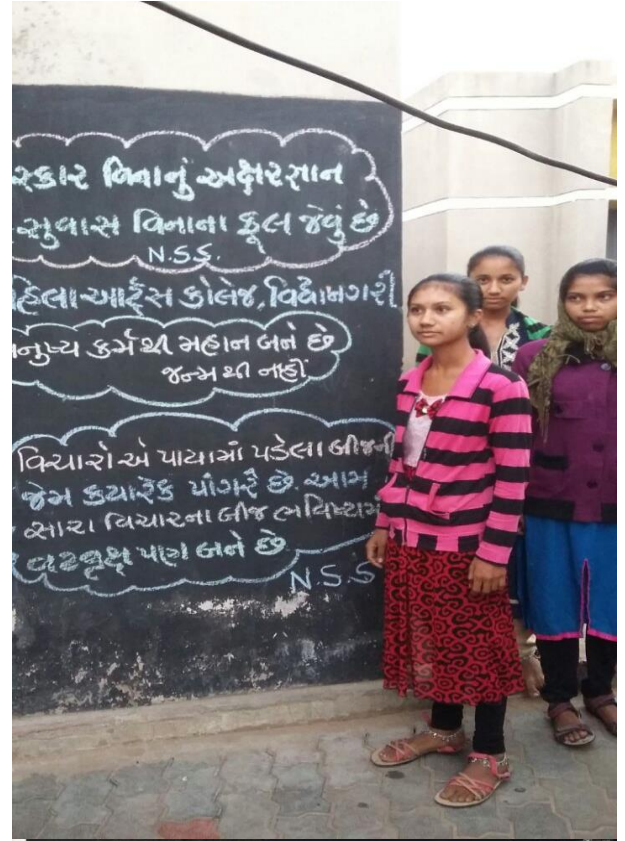

13.10 Relief and Rescue Program in Flood Affected Areas by NSS Units of HNG University in Banaskantha and Patan Districts:

Due to heavy rain in July 2017, state of Gujarat was affected by severe flood. The flood were reported to have caused total 224 deaths between 1 June and 31 July 2017. 16 people had died in Neighboring Rajasthan state by 31 July 2017.

The monsoon season in Gujarat typically starts in mid-June. In the 2017 season low pressure systems developed over the Arabian Sea and the Bay of Bengal simultaneously, resulting in heavy rainfall. Moderate rain began across the state on 14 July, and heavy rains fall from 21 to 25 July.

A week of torrential rains leading to flood wreaked havoc in north Gujarat, State Revenue Department has declared Banaskantha and Patan districts as 'disaster-affected areas'. The districts of Banaskantha and Patan, received 267% and 208%, respectively of their average rainfall for the same period. As on 1 August, at least 224 people had died in floods in Gujarat since 1 June due to rain-related causes. Among them, 61 deaths were recorded in Banaskantha. The districts in north Gujarat received more than 200 mm of rainfall in 24 hours on 24 July. Dhanera recorded 235 mm rainfall in six hours on 24 July resulting in severe flooding. Deesa recorded 269 mm rainfall.

More than 113,000 people were evacuated to safety places and more than 17,000 of them were rescued with the help of the Indian Army, Indian Air Force (IAF), the Border Security Force(BSF), the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) and the State Disaster Response Force (SDRF). Ten IAF helicopters, five Army Columns, 18 BSF Teams and 32 Teams from the NDRF, 11 Teams from the SDRF and the Local Teams were deployed for rescue and relief operations. Over 20,00,000 food packets were distributed in affected districts in North Gujarat. 12,000 people were moved to safety places and at least 100 people were rescued in Rajasthan 90 relief camps were set up for affected people. The electricity supply was restored in 700 villages. More than 1,500 sanitation workers were deployed in Banaskantha and Patan districts to prevent outbreaks. And more than 10,400 carcasses were disposed

The Government of India announced an interim relief package of 500 Crores. It is also announced that ex gratia of 2,00,000 will be given to the next of kin of the deceased and 50,000 to people seriously injured in the floods.

Due to heavy rain in June-July 2017, Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University, Patan had arranged meeting for rescue, relief and relief fund works in Banaskantha and Patan Districts in Chairmanship of the Vice Chancellor, Prof. B.A. Prajapati on 3rd July 2017 at 3:30 p.m. at Room No. 15, Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University, Patan Officers of this University, Members of Executive Council, Members of University Court, Heads of University Departments and Sections, Representative of Principals of affiliated Colleges, President of Professor Union of affiliated Colleges, Representatives of University Teachers Associations and Representatives of Nonteaching Staff Unions of University were present in this Meeting.



NSS Section circulated a circular to all affiliated colleges of Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University, Patan wide Circular No. 147/2017 on 3rd August 2017 for relief fund in flood areas. Relief and Rescued with the help of the NSS Units of Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University, Patan.

Following Colleges visited Banaskantha and Patan District Flood Affected Villages and Distributed Food, Blankets and other things to villagers and also carried on relief and rescue works.

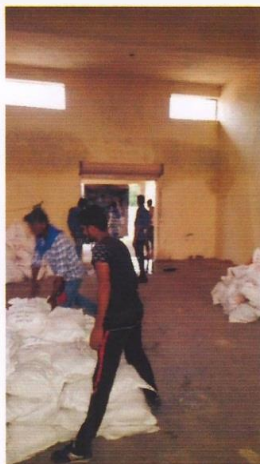

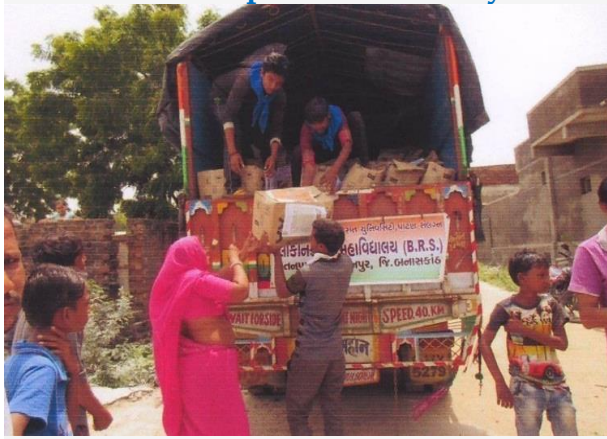
